The Butler County Conservation Board has a goal to educate others and to support others who educate the community about conservation of our natural resources. That is why the Butler County Conservation District Board of Supervisors has allocated \$ 500 to provide materials for projects related to conservation education in Butler County Schools. The number of grants the amount for each grant will be determined after reviewing the applications. The projects are to be designed to educate students about the conservation of our natural resources and how it affects our community.

Examples of projects would be: Outdoor classrooms, nature trails, compost demonstrations, recycling projects, wildlife feeding/observation stations, soil and water testing, land judging instruments, bird feeders, nesting boxes, food plots, conservations books, conservation slides or video presentations. These are just a few of the possibilities for the projects, just as long as it relates to educating students about conservation of our natural resources.

Applications will be reviewed and approved once each quarter throughout the year as funds are available. At that time the money will be sent to the school board where it will be readily available for use on the project. The District will request a report on the project upon completion and a copy of all receipts. The projects may continue for more than one school year, but if so, a report should be made at the end of each year to the District Board about the progress of the project.

Application forms are attached and may be back to the Butler County Conservation District at any time. We encourage anyone interested to apply.
