

Butler County Middle School
SBDM Meeting Minutes
April 15, 2019

The Butler County Middle School SBDM council met on April 15, 2019. The following SBDM members were present: Thomas Harper, Melissa Renfrow, Monica Crawford, Kim Grubb, John Embry, and Principal Tim Freeman led the meeting.

- **Meeting was called to order at 3:18 PM.**
- **Approval of Agenda:** Mr. Freeman asked for the approval of the agenda as written. Mr. Harper requested that the Beta trip for May 23rd be put on the agenda for approval. Mrs. Grubb made the motion to approve, and it was seconded by Mrs. Renfrow. Consensus was met.
